Federal Government Debt at end January 2018

The Belgian Federal Government Debt amounted to EUR 389.15 billion as of 31 January 2018. Debt issued or taken over by the federal government amounted to EUR 388.90 billion, and the institutions for which the federal government supports the debt service, registered a debt of EUR 0.25 billion.

In net terms (i.e. deducting financial deposits and investments, as well as securities owned by the Treasury), the Federal Government Debt amounted to EUR 374.42 billion.
