Federal Government Debt at the end of June 2024

As of the end of June 2024, the federal government debt amounted to EUR 521.609 billion. Federal government debt thus decreased by EUR 11.50 billion since May.

In net terms (after deducting placements and securities held in portfolio), the federal government debt increased by EUR 4.02 billion to EUR 501.394 billion.

The net balance to be financed amounted to EUR 4.012 billion (to the detriment of the Treasury).

The average maturity of the federal government debt decreased by 0.12 year to 10.64 years, while the average interest rate of the debt instruments remained stable at 1.94%. The 12-month and 60-month refinancing risks amounted to 13.74% and 38.12% respectively.
